REQUIREMENTS

- Master's degree
- Three years of successful teaching experience with a Massachusetts initial or professional educator license
- Letter of recommendation from the district Superintendent of Schools
- Support of an in-school mentor who agrees to work with the candidate. The mentor must possess the professional license the candidate is seeking.

\$2,900 to Worcester State University, plus an additional **\$500 PALS fee**
